#### Dear Friends,

If you spend any time on social media, you will see "#\_\_\_goals" memes. You might see a photo of sandy toes with a beautiful shoreline behind them, bearing the text, #vacationgoals. Maybe the picture is of a couple doing yoga together: #relationshipgoals. Goals...we all have them, from the simple to the sublime, as do the characters in our stellar line-up of shows for this Season: Sweeney Todd, Anything Goes, and Pippin.

In Sweeney Todd, the title character is driven by a singular objective: revenge.
