







THE STORY: Pearl Diver





EXT. OCEAN - OFF THE COAST OF SIREN ISLAND. DAY.

An instrumental version of "Metal Hearts" by Cat Powers plays. Twangs of guitars play with the sounds of choppy waves crashing against huge rocks.

Sabrina (19) a young siren props herself up on a rock in the ocean. She is frail from years of only eating small fish and dried kelp, but she possesses the siren familial traits glossy, long hair, sultry eyes. She is a nervous creature, always skirting away, but she occasionally gives into her innate curiosity.

Her legs dangle over the waves.

Sabrina sings into the sea, practicing. Her voice comes out weak and unsteady, like screeches or nails against a chalk board.

Alex (22), an older, more mature siren appears from the water. A stern leader for the younger sirens, Alex preaches their way of life, but she holds a tenderness for Sabrina.

Alex emerges from the water.

ALEX You aren't singing from the heart.

Sabrina jumps at Alex's arrival.

ALEX (CONT'D) You should have sensed me coming, Sabrina. Know your surroundings. Who is in the water. Who is breathing near you.

SABRINA I'm singing from the heart.

Alex hoists herself onto the rock beside Sabrina. They perch on it together.

The sun peeks out from the horizon, rising.

SABRINA (CONT'D) Why aren't you asleep?

ALEX If you were singing from the heart, the sailors would come. No sailors.

SABRINA I was just practicing.
