Eligibility and Application Materials

Students become eligible for the award at the start of the 4th year in the PhD Program and having taught, as instructor of record, at least two courses (tokens, not necessarily types) for our department. To be considered for the award, the student must submit this form (preferably compiled as a single PDF document, with table of contents if appropriate): (a) a completed application form (available on the Graduate Student News page); (b) sample syllabi for each course taught; (c) course evaluations for each course taught; (d) any additional documents the student wishes as further evidence of their excellence in teaching, such as a teaching statement, sample assignments, notes from students, etc. The student should notify faculty members who have visited his or her courses to have peer reviews submitted to the Director of Graduate Studies.

List all courses previously taught for the Tulane Philosophy Department in reverse chronological order (i.e., begin with the most recent completed) and provide information requested in the columns. In the last line provide the weighted average of the ratings across all courses taught, with weighing to the number of evaluations submitted for that course.
