

## ARTICULATION OF TRANSFER COURSEWORK FOR GRADUATE PROGRAMS

- This form should be submitted to the Registrar's Office by the appropriate department or school faculty or staff and should not be submitted by students.
- This form must be accompanied by an OFFICIAL transcript. Submit one form per transfer institution.
- International transcripts should be accompanied by a **credential evaluation**.
- This form is for students who are transferring coursework from a school other than Tulane University that meets a requirement for their current graduate program at Tulane.
- If a transfer course does not have an equivalent Tulane course but should apply to degree requirements, enter the Tulane course number using the subject area code with the number 7940\*, which is the course number for general graduate transfer coursework. For example, a computer science course would be indicated as CMPS 7940.
- If a course articulated as **7940\*** should fulfill a requirement in the audit, **submit a degree audit petition** to place the course in the audit correctly.
- If an equivalent Tulane course did not exist in the student's first term in the program, it will be articulated as 7940\*.
- Articulating a transfer course as equivalent to a Tulane course means that the **equivalency applies to all students transferring the course**. If COMS 573 from Example State University is articulated as Tulane course number CMPS 6720, any student transferring in COMS 573 will get credit for CMPS 6720.
- **50% of all credits** for a graduate degree must be completed at Tulane.
- Undergraduate transfer coursework cannot be articulated as equivalent to Tulane graduate coursework.
- When awarding transfer credit, the number of **credit hours added to a student's Tulane record must reflect the credits earned at the originating institution**, as determined by the original institution's calendar type or applicable foreign credit multipliers (e.g., 1 quarter credit = 0.67 semester credits; 2 ECTS credits = 1 semester credit). Credit values cannot be adjusted to align with Tulane's course credit structure and must remain equivalent to those awarded by the original institution.

\* The School of Social Work uses 6940 as their general transfer coursework number.
