SCHOOL OF LIBERAL ARTS – GRADUATE PROGRAMS CONTINUOUS REGISTRATION

A student admitted to the School of Liberal Arts in a graduate degree program must be in continuous registration in a degree granting division of the University until the awarding of the degree. Any student who is not registered for course work in a degree-granting division of the University must be registered in Master's Research or Dissertation Research in order to remain in continuous registration.

The continuous registration requirement applies to both students in residence and those not in residence. Students who have completed their minimum course work requirements, or students who temporarily interrupt their program of study, are required to register for 9980 (Master's Research) or 9990 (Dissertation Research) each semester. This entitles students in residence or non-residence to full student privileges.

If you do not intend to register for either full-time or part-time course work next semester, you must register as indicated below before the end of September for the fall semester or the end of February for the spring semester.
